

Rob Lewis' Mojovisity



RL's Laidback Parachute

Materials

Hook: TMC 100 #12

Thread: Uni Chartreuse 8/0

Tails: Dunn Microfibbets

Abdomen: Turkey Biot

Ribbing: none

Thorax:

Wing: Grey Poly Yarn

Hackle: Grizzly size 10

Head: Thread

Instructions

Tie in yarn ¼ from eye wrap to ½ point, angle trim

Tie hackle stem to hook behind eye and wrap to post

Wrap base 2-3x, lift hackle and yarn and wrap post

Tie off behind, tilt post back 45° & cement

At barb tie 3 microfibbet tails/side=1¼ body length

Use biot or dub thin twisted abdomen to post

Dub a heavier thorax

Parachute hackle from top down

Pull post and hackle back and tie off towards eye

Form head, wet thread and whip finish

Separate wing to compress hackle downwards



Daiichi Scud Hook #12

Uni Chartreuse 8/0 ("or it ain't no use)

EP Fiber (Antron)

Turkey Barbs (4)

Light copper wire

Yellow Dubbing

EP Fiber post

Grizzly size 10

Thread

Wrap thread to back of barb

Tie in long piece of Antron shuck ¼ back from eye

Lift up wing to form post

Tie stripped hackle butt to shank and up post

Wrap & stagger cut fibers to bend/beyond as shuck

Tie in wire(fold and bind tag) & turkey barbs

Wrap barbs to ¼ length behind post

Counter wrap barbs with cooper wire just to keel fly

Dub prominent thorax (diff colors for diff flies)

Parachute wrap hackle down stem and tie off

Form head and whip finish

RL's Delaware Emerger

RL also tied Harrop CDC emerger (with CDC butt legs); has good stonefly imitation for another time.
